WORMING

What wormer to use and when to use it? What are we treating for? These are questions we are commmonly asked.






- THE USE OF WORM EGG COUNTS
- Worm egg counts prevent the un-necessary and ineffective use of wormers, save money for those horses not needing treatment and minimises the problem of resistance. (Resistance to a wormer is where the product used becomes ineffective at killing the intended parasite.)
- Tapeworm test kits are also availble for purchase from the practice.



Most common parasites seen in the adult

horse and that we routinely treat for are:



WHAT ARE WE TREATING FOR

- Small Strongyles (cyathostomes)
- Roundworms
- Tapeworms
- Pinworms
- Bots

WAYS TO HELP KEEP PASTURE PARASITE BURDENS LOWS

- Test all new horses upon arrival.
- Test and treat all horses in the herd at the same time.
- Regular dung collection, at least 2-3 times a week.
- Avoid overstocking and over grazing, 1.5 acre (0.4 hectares) per horse ideally.
- Rotate paddocks with alternating periods of rest & cross grazing cattle and or sheep to clean up the deposited eggs and larvae.

We are running a vaccine amnesty throughout March for any horse that needs to restart the course or has not been vaccinated (excluding primary courses for foals). The first vaccination must be given in March and the second vaccination in 4-6 weeks later, see below for information on prices.
