SIGNS OF DENTAL PAIN

- Difficulty eating/quidding

- Nasal discharge/excessive saliva
- Unpleasant odour
- Head tossing
- Fussing with the bit
- · Difficult under saddle/tilting head

DENTAL CAMERA

We have a specifically designed dental camera, enabling us to have a close up look at the grinding surface of your horse's teeth. This is essential in order to pick up early changes and also to help visualise the area when we have specific work to undertake on a tooth which left unmanaged can result in abnormal wear and even fractures after time. Using the camera offers a more detailed exam of your horse's teeth to identify these issues before they become a problem.



BE WORM WISE

We would like to thank everyone who joined us for our be worm wise client event and hope you all enjoyed the evening. Within the practice we will now be offering a worming programme; this will include the following- 3 FEC during the grazing season (Mar-Oct), 1 free retest if resistance is suspected, 1 Tapeworm Saliva Test / yr, 1 Small Redworm Blood Test, our advice, and email reminders when your tests are due. The cost for the programme for the year will be £65. Further information on this will be sent out direct to clients via email over the coming weeks.
