EQUINE HERPES VACCINE

We can't always see it, but EHV is still present and is a highly contagious airborne disease. Equine Herpes Viruses, commonly referred to as EHV, are a group of viruses which can cause a contagious disease in horses. Vaccination can shorten the duration of the virus in infected horses, help limit the spread and reduce future outbreaks. EHV is a potentially serious contagious disease threat that every horse owner should be aware of and take steps to prevent. Understanding what EHV is, how it spreads and how to protect against it will help to minimise the risks to your horses. Please contact the practice for more information on this topic.

A HIDDEN THREAT

EHV VACCINE COURSE

- 1st vaccination
- 2nd vaccination- 4-6 weeks after 1st vaccine
- Boosters 6 monthly from date of 2nd vaccine, then ongoing

from previous date

The cost of the EHV vaccine is £40.56 (excl visit fee). Contact the practice for more information on starting your horse's vaccination course.

PREVENTATIVE HEALTHCARE

Preventative healthcare is key in playing a vital role to optimise and protect the heath and welfare of your horses and the herd/yard as a whole, helping to minimise the risk of illness and diseases.

- Vaccinations are a central recommendation of the disease control strategy (Equine Influenza & Tetanus, Equine Herpes Virus)
- Worm egg counts/ Tapeworm saliva tests/ Redworm Blood tests
- Routine dental checks
