#### LOAN AGREEMENTS - T&C'S

For many owners loaning is an ideal solution, whether it's due to growing out of their ponies or horses, unforeseen circumstances or just that they don't want to sell them.

For the loanee it can be a great introduction into having a horse of your own, or allow people to have their own horse without the initial purchase expense.

Loaning a horse out allows owners to maintain control over their horse, with the loanee taking on the day to day care, however agreements need to be in place to protect both owners and loanees. This also ensures that the horse's needs are met.

Having these measures in place protects all parties involved and helps any professional that may treat the horse know who is the point of contact.

In the event of a horse being on loan we request that, prior to the commencement of any services, the loanee agreement is sent to Farr and Pursey Equine Services Ltd. If a loanee agreement is not in place, or if Farr and Pursey Equine Veterinary Services Ltd have not been informed in writing of any specific clinical or financial requirements by either the loanee or legal owner of the animal, the owner or loaner booking the appointment will be liable for any fees associated with such work.
