CARE ABOUT CUSHINGS

The campaign enables clients to claim free labs fees for annual testing, saving yourself around £40 per year with a few simple steps! Once your account has been set up you will need to upload information on your horse in order for the free annual voucher code to be generated.

Equine Cushing's disease (PPID) can cause a wide range of symptoms in horses over the age of 10 and is the 5th most common disease syndrome recognised in horses and ponies in the UK.

Equine Cushing's disease (PPID) is a hormonal disease caused by changes in the pituitary gland in the brain.

Horses with Equine Cushing's disease don't produce enough dopamine which means the pituitary gland becomes uncontrolled and produces too many hormones. One of these hormones is called ACTH, which is why your vet carries out an ACTH test to test for Equine Cushing's.
