INFLUENZA VACCINES- GUIDELINES

Any horse receiving a new Primary Course as of 1st January 2024 must be vaccinated according to the following schedule:

- Initial vaccination administered
- Second vaccination must be administered 21-60 days after 1st vaccine
- Third vaccination (first booster) must be administered 120-180 days after the 2nd vaccine

Subsequent booster vaccinations must be administered at a maximum of 12 month intervals. However, horses competing in certain events must have received a booster within 6 months +21 days (and not within 7 days) before arrival at a competition.

We recommend all clients check the guidelines with their representing governing body.

When competing, horses may compete 7 days after receiving the second vaccination of the primary course.
