EQUINE CUSHING'S DISEASE (PPID)

The simplest and most common test for Equine Cushing's disease is the basal ACTH blood test. This will require a blood sample from your horse to send to the laboratory that will measure the levels of a hormone called ACTH. The results of the test will then be compared to reference ranges (which will change with the seasons) to confirm the presence or absence of Equine Cushing's disease.

The measurement of insulin and glucose is often recommended alongside the basal ACTH test. These tests help to differentiate Equine Cushing's disease from Equine Metabolic Syndrome (EMS), and also act as an indicator of laminitis risk.

CARE ABOUT CUSHING'S

Is your horse on treatment for Cushing's but still not signed up to Care about Cushing's? Care About Cushing's is an online resource to support owners with the lifelong management of PPID. It allows you to manage your horse's PPID history, save diary entries and upload photographs to monitor their progress.

MONITORING CODES

- If your horse or pony is on treatment for PPID and currently on Prascend, then you qualify for 1 free* monitoring laboratory test per year (*A take and send fee & visit fee we still be invoiced)
- Monitoring codes will be sent directly to clients to then be passed on to the practice when a blood test has been booked.
- To enable your FOC code to be generated it is the client's responsibility to keep the details on your horse's account up to date after each test.
